There have been 600 attacks against Christians and other religious minorities in India since May of this year. Most of those involved won't receive justice or adequate compensation unless we take action.

India's constitution guarantees the Indian people's right to religious freedom. The reality is a different story:

- 54,000 people displaced
- 10,000 children had their studies disrupted
- 5,600 homes destroyed
- 2,000 forcibly converted
- 600 villages pillaged
- 100 people were killed

...in just one outbreak of anti-Christian violence. It's been six years since that attack, and the victims/survivors still haven't received justice.

India's Prime Minister, Narendra Modi, is visiting the United States for the first time next week and will be meeting members of Congress and President Barack Obama. This is your chance to call for justice on behalf of the victims.

The relationship between India and the United States is one of the top four priorities identified by President Obama and Secretary of State John Kerry. We need your help to make sure the rights of India's religious minorities are on the agenda.
